ABOUT THE CRADLE OF AVIATION MUSEUM:

The Cradle of Aviation Museum celebrates the remarkable accomplishments and contributions of Long Island to our nation's development and to the history of aviation. The Museum features 75 fascinating exhibits, a giant domed-screen theater, the X-Ride flight simulator experience, a historic carousel ride, a Firefighters Museum and the Mars-themed Red Planet Cafe.

The Cradle of Aviation Museum is located on Museum Row/Charles Lindbergh Boulevard in Garden City, NY, near the Nassau Coliseum, Nassau Community College and Hofstra University. Visitors coming by car should take Exit M4 off the Meadowbrook Parkway onto Museum Row, then turn right at the second traffic light into the Museum's driveway. For mass transit options, buses N16, N45, and N51 buses stop several blocks from the Museum at Nassau Community College, and anyone taking the Long Island Railroad can reach the Museum by taxi from the Garden City, Mineola and Westbury stations.
